<i>Note: The examiner must advise the candidate to discontinue oxygen therapy.</i>		
Removes the nasal cannula	1	
Shuts off the regulator	1

	Did not assemble the tank and regulator without leaks	
	Did not prefill the reservoir bag	
	Did not adjust the device to the correct liter flow for the nonrebreather mask (12 liter per minute or greater)	
	Did not adjust the device to the correct liter flow for the nasal cannula (up to 6 liter per minute)
