OVERVIEW OF PARAMEDIC PROGRAM
PHASE I- PHASE III

This is to serve as an overview of the various stages of the Phase I –Phase III Programs, registration processes and tuition/costs.

If you are a graduate from a CCA EMS 125 (EMT-Basic) class or if you are EMT-Basic certified from another program, the EMS Program administrative staff will register you for EMS 225 (Phase I) (15 credit hours). IV Certification is a prerequisite to entering Phase I. Phase I is closed to outside registration.

Once you complete Phase I you can then be registered for EMS 228 – Phase II (13 credit hours). Upon completion of EMS 228, you will then be registered for EMS 280 (17 credit hours). Phase III is primarily comprised of real-life lab rotations through the program’s simulation studios and the Internship Phase of the program. The same process applies for registration to these classes as indicated for Phase I.

If you are eligible for COF, the following estimates apply:

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| EMS 225 (<i>Phase I</i>) 15 credit hours | \$1,775.00 tuition/costs |
| EMS 228 (<i>Phase II</i>) 13 credit hours | \$1,498.00 tuition/costs |
| EMS 280 (<i>Phase III</i>) 17 credit hours | \$2,053.00 tuition/costs |
| Totals | ** \$5,326.Phase I – Phase III |

You will be responsible for paying for 45 credit hours (EMS 225, 228 & 280).
