CERTIFICATE INFORMATION

The Director Certificate is based on the Colorado Dept. of Human Services, Division of Child Care, and Community Colleges of Colorado System Early Childhood Professions' requirements for directors of child care centers. Students must complete 30 credit hours of required ECE courses to satisfy the academic requirements. The Division of Child Care also requires 3640 hours (24 months) of experience working directly with children under first grade in a child development program.
