

General Information:

1. This articulated degree is designed for students wanting to transfer into an elementary education program at a public four-year college in Colorado. To receive elementary education licensure, you must transfer to a 4-year institution.
2. Your intended transfer institution will design your final 15 credits for transfer and to complete your AA degree. It is vital to contact them during your first semester. IMPORTANT TRANSFER INFORMATION

A Colorado community college student who is planning to become an elementary education teacher will sign a graduation plan at the community college that identifies the first 45 hours (listed above) that are guaranteed to transfer to all teacher education programs at the following Colorado public four-year colleges: Adams State College (Interdisciplinary Studies), Colorado State University at Pueblo (Liberal Studies), Fort Lewis College (Interdisciplinary Studies), Mesa State College (Liberal Arts), Metropolitan State College of Denver (6 majors), University of Colorado at Boulder (History), University of Colorado at Colorado Springs (English, History/Social Studies, Modern Foreign Languages, Science, and Mathematics), University of Colorado at Denver (Individually Structured Major), University of Northern Colorado (Interdisciplinary Studies), Western State College (Interdisciplinary Studies)

To complete the AA/elementary education graduation requirements, students who have completed or are currently enrolled in courses that will total the first 45 credits will apply to a specific teacher education program and be advised on the final 15 credits guaranteed to transfer.
