Philosophy		One course. PHI 111, 112, or 113 recommended.
Creative Arts		A course in fine arts, music, dance, theatre, literature, photography, film, or other creative arts. A third or fourth level language course with a literature component is also acceptable.
English Composition	ENG 122 – 3 cr.	English Composition II
Cultural Anthropology or Multicultural Studies	ANT 101 – 3cr. Or WST – 3 cr.	Cultural Anthropology or a course in women's studies.
