

**Transfer Information for B.S.N.-Nursing Degree  
at Regis University, 2005-06**

The undergraduate curriculum in the Department of Nursing incorporates four years of study. To receive the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree, students must earn a total of 128 semester hours of credit. The undergraduate curriculum prepares graduates to work in a changing health care environment that focuses on health promotion and disease prevention. The first two years consist of a liberal arts/science curriculum while the third and fourth years focus on required nursing courses. Studies during the freshman and sophomore years include the life sciences (microbiology, chemistry, anatomy and physiology), the social and behavioral sciences, and nutrition. Courses in humanities and liberal arts, as well as religious studies and philosophy, are required to provide a broad, humanistic view of the world and its people.
