STATEWIDE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION TRANSFER AGREEMENT

A community college student who is planning to become an Elementary Education Teacher will sign a graduation plan at the community college that identifies the first 41 credit hours that are guaranteed to transfer to particular teacher education programs that are offered by Colorado public institutions of higher education. The courses are listed below.

To complete the AA graduation requirements, students who have completed or are currently enrolled in courses that will total the first 41 credits will consult a specific teacher education program and be advised on the final 19 credits guaranteed to transfer.

This agreement is between the Colorado Public Community/Junior Colleges and Adams State College, Colorado State University at Pueblo, Fort Lewis College, Mesa State College, Metropolitan State College of Denver, University of Colorado at Denver, University of Northern Colorado, and Western State College.
