

1. The AA degree incorporates statewide guaranteed transfer courses and is transferable to four-year institutions. Admission is up to the four-year institution. When choosing electives, it is important to contact an advisor and the transfer institution's transfer guide. For guides to CO public colleges & universities, visit <http://highered.colorado.gov/Academics/Transfers/Guides/default.html>. Some majors require specific electives.
2. Special articulation agreements exist for Elementary Education, Early Childhood Education, Business, and Engineering. Be sure to follow the correct program and contact an advisor and your college of transfer intent early in your program.
3. You must apply for graduation on the website or at Enrollment Services prior to your final semester.

STATEWIDE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION TRANSFER AGREEMENT

A Colorado community college student who is planning to become an early childhood educator will sign a graduation plan at the community college that identifies the first 54 hours that are guaranteed to transfer to all teacher education programs at the following Colorado public four-year colleges: Adams State College, Colorado State University (Human Development), Fort Lewis College, Mesa State College, Metropolitan State College of Denver (Human Development), University of Northern Colorado (Interdisciplinary Studies).
