

## CCA and Regis Articulation Agreement – AAS/Accounting Crosswalk for Students Transferring to Regis University

**Program Info:** Students can transfer up to 90 credits to Regis and earn an AAS/Accounting at CCA. Students receiving financial aid should work closely with the financial aid office in order to be eligible for funding for the entire program. Students should apply to Regis when your AAS degree at CCA is completed. Credits taken here can then be applied to your financial aid award from Regis.

CCA students will be able to complete 90 of the 128 credits required for Regis University's Bachelor of Science in Accounting, Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Bachelor of Science in Computer Information Systems, Bachelor of Science in Computer Networking, Bachelor of Science in Computer Science, and a Bachelor of Science in Business Technology Management and successfully transfer up to 90 credits to Regis University for their final year of study.
