HCA Students need to complete one course with a Non-US focus. Examples include: Cultural Anthropology, European History, World Religions, and Foreign Languages. Hispanic and Latino Studies are not considered a Non-US focus.

HCA PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

There are specific requirements that you must meet to be eligible for the HCA program at Regis University. Please see the following eligibility requirements:

- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. (Note: Applicants with a GPA below 2.0 will be considered on an individual basis by the Department of Health Services Administration.)
- Completion of 12 semester hours of college-level coursework prior to the HCA curriculum. One course must be English Composition.
