

Registering for Classes through MyCommunity Education when you know the course(s) CRN



If you use the paper schedule to choose your classes, write down the CRN numbers of the courses you want to add to your schedule. The CRN number is a five-digit number that identifies each individual class section. Once you've identified your courses, go online to register for classes.

1. Click the MyCommunity Education logo (shown above) on CCA's homepage at www.CCAurora.edu.
2. Login to your student account by using your Student ID and PIN numbers. Make sure to use a capital "S" for your student ID to get into the system
3. Click on Student Menu
4. Click on Add or Drop Classes from the Quick Links at the top of the page
5. Choose your semester from the menu
6. Input CRN numbers in Add Classes Worksheet portion of Add or Drop Classes screen
