



Community College of Aurora International Student Affidavit of Financial Support

The Community College of Aurora requires that all applications for F-1 and M-1 Student Visas provide documentation of Financial Support while attending CCA. You must have adequate financial resources to provide for your educational and living expenses without having to resort to unauthorized employment. Affidavits of Financial Support and bank statements must be dated within six months prior to entering CCA. The bank statements must be on the financial institution's letterhead (or contain a financial institution stamp or seal) and must indicate funds in US dollars.

The Community College of Aurora must have verification of your financial resources before we will issue a form I-20. We are unable to issue an I-20 based upon faxed or photocopied records.

Instructions to students: Please complete the information below and then give a copy (front and back) to each of your sponsors. Ask that your sponsors complete the second page of this Affidavit and attach their supporting documentation. Once you have collected Affidavits and documentation from all of your sponsors, submit the completed forms to the Community College of Aurora.
