The Academic Learning Center offers help with D2L by enrolling students into a free **D2L Student Training**. To enroll in this training, contact Kevin Dunbar at **303-340-7247** or email Kevin.Dunbar@ccaaurora.edu.

In this training, students participate in a series of self-paced modules to learn and practice key features of D2L including: how to submit homework in the Dropbox, how to communicate with instructors and classmates, how to take a quiz, how to check their grades, and much more.

Access to Computers

The ALC has computers and printers for student use at both campuses. Desktop computers are equipped with headphone jack and USB ports for thumb drives.



Access to Adaptive Technology

The ALC has computers equipped with software for accessibility use only, which includes: Kurzweil (a text reading software for the visually impaired and dyslexic), Dragon Speak (Speech recognition software), and Zoom Text (a magnification software for low-vision users). The table height can be adjusted for use.
