

Patient Care Technician

Thank you for your interest in the Patient Care Technician (PCT) program at the Community College of Aurora. The PCT program consists of CNA, Phlebotomy, and four additional courses comprising 21 credits and can be completed in two semesters. Please meet with a Pathways Advisor on either campus for assistance with registering.

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Provide proof of all required vaccinations*
- Complete a criminal background check and drug screen*
- Meet all CCA admissions and placement requirements
- **English Competency – must display one of the following:**
 - ✓ Successful completion of CCR 092 (with C or better) or equivalent assessment scores
 - ✓ English ACT of 18 or SAT of 440
 - ✓ Successful completion of ESL 043 & 053 coursework
 - ✓ College degree of AA, AS or higher



* After you have enrolled into the courses, email the Allied Health Program Assistant to get the required documentation checklist, additional forms needed, and to set up a PIN to process the background check and drug screen.

Tuition, COF stipend, and fee amounts are subject to change. The Patient Care Technician Certificate program is financial aid eligible. Please declare it as your Priority 1 degree plan in your CCA student account. A payment plan is also available.

To receive your Phlebotomy Certificate and CNA Certificate from CCA upon completion, please declare it as your Priority 2 degree plan in the semester you are taking it and apply for graduation before the deadline for the semester. You cannot take Phlebotomy and CNA in the same semester do to conflicts in scheduling.
